Project Proposal Form for Organisers

European Heritage Volunteers Projects are projects in the field of heritage-linked volunteering that are initiated by an organisation or institution based in a European country (referring to the definition of Europe of the Council of Europe). In the frame of the European Heritage Volunteers Projects volunteers from different European and Non-European countries contribute by their practical work to the rescue, the conservation, the restoration and / or the revitalisation of a particular heritage site of international, national or regional importance havingin the same time the opportunity to widen their heritage-linked knowledge and their heritage-linked skills.

European Heritage Training Courses – as far as they are not organised by European Heritage Volunteers itself – follow in general the same scheme, but since they include also preparatory educational activities providing basic heritage-linked knowledge and skills in the particular field their focus lies – in comparison to the European Heritage Volunteers Projects – more on providing heritage linked knowledge and skills and in a smaller extent on contributing to the conservation of the particular heritage site.

European Heritage Volunteers Projects and European Heritage Training Courses are required to fulfil certain criteria, in particular a **high-quality approach to the heritage-related activities** as well as certain **standards concerning volunteering respectively educational activities**, group dynamics and intercultural exchange.

European Heritage Volunteers provides **mentorship** to the European Heritage Volunteers Projects and the European Heritage Training Courses and supports their conceptual development, providing advice and models of best-practice.

In addition, European Heritage Volunteers **supports** the Project Partners by **promoting** their projects and training courses by **linking** them **to European wide heritage-linked campaigns**, activities and events, by recruiting international volunteers, as well as by **providing networking opportunities**, **trainings** for technical instructors and group coordinators, **evaluation**, feedback and **follow-up activities**.

Finally, European Heritage Volunteers **might provide a financial support** to the particular Project Partner to enable a project or course, to strengthen its professional quality or to support its promotion on local, regional or national level.

The Project Partner is **allowed to use** for the promotion of the project European Heritage Volunteers **logo adding the sentence** "in collaboration with European Heritage Volunteers".

The deadline for application for projects and courses in March or April 2022 will be December, 24th, 2021, and for projects and courses from July to December 2022 will be January, 15th, 2022.

The decision regarding which projects and courses will be part of the European Heritage Volunteers Programme 2022 will be undertaken for projects and courses planned for March or April 2022 till January, 15th, 2022, and for projects and courses from July to December 2022 till February, 10th, 2022.


